Award Criteria

1. The *Citizen of the Year* recipient shall have made outstanding VOLUNTARY contributions toward the benefit of the greater Tomball area community. (No award will be given for those doing a “paid” job.)
Example – areas to be considered include:
 - A. Civic/Community Service
 - B. Professional Service
 - C. Church Involvement
 - D. Achievements in Other Organizations
 - E. Chamber of Commerce Service
 - F. Other
2. The *Citizen of the Year* recipient may be of any race, age, sex and from any or no religious or political affiliation.
3. The *Citizen of the Year* recipient shall live or work in the greater Tomball area community and their contribution shall be focused there.
4. The *Citizen of the Year* recipient may or may not be a member of the Greater Tomball Area Chamber of Commerce.
5. The *Citizen of the Year* recipient is eligible to win only one time.
6. Nominations for the *2009 Citizen of the Year* will be accepted through Monday, December 7, 2009. Appropriate public notice will be given that nominations are being accepted. All nominations will be considered, including those that may be proposed by the Selection Committee.
7. Final selection of the recipient will be made by the Selection Committee which shall consist of the following:
 - ⌘ The most recent recipient and every prior recipient of *Citizen of the Year*.
 - ⌘ The Chairman of the Board of the Greater Tomball Area Chamber of Commerce and the two most immediate past chairmen.
 - ⌘ Four members to be elected by the Board of Directors, who are Board members of the Greater Tomball Area Chamber of Commerce and who have served on the Board in prior years.
8. The Selection Committee will meet and make their selection prior to January 1, 2010. The award will be presented at the annual Greater Tomball Area Chamber of Commerce Chairman’s Ball to be held on Friday, January 29, 2010.
